### **MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING**

#### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MADRID COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2021**

##### **I. Call to Order**

The Board of Directors for the Madrid Community School District met for a special meeting on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 in the Madrid Administration Office. Meeting was called to order by President Lauren Clark at 5:30pm.

##### **II. Roll Call**

Members present Allie Antonovich, Chelcie Badgley, Lauren Clark, Tyler Simmons and Jessica Smith. Superintendent Brian Horn, Board Secretary Kris Van Pelt, Principal Kelly Williamson, Activities Director Justin Johnson and two other guests were also in attendance.

III. Hearing Concerning the Recommended Discipline of a Student (Closed Session - Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(e) and Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(a))

Moved by Antonovich the Board conduct a hearing to consider disciplinary action against a student as provided by Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(e) and to review and discuss records which are required by state or federal law to be kept confidential as provided by Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(a). Seconded by Simmons. Roll call: Badgley, Simmons, Smith, Antonovich, Clark. Motion carried 5-0. The board entered into closed session at 5:32pm.

The Board returned to open session at 6:45pm.

IV. Action Regarding Recommended Discipline of a Student

Moved by Antonovich that the Board accept the superintendent's recommendation, with the following amendments:

- That the student who was the subject of the disciplinary hearing be expelled from attendance in the Madrid Community School District and any school activities for the duration of the original suspension, through December 6, 2021.

- That upon completion of the expulsion period, an application for re-admission must be submitted and approved by the superintendent pri-

or to re-admission on November 29, 2021.

- At the family's own expense, the Student must successfully show proof of a scheduled appointment for a substance abuse evaluation by November 29, 2021. The student must show proof of completion of a substance abuse evaluation and, if appropriate partake in any therapy or treatment program recommended by the substance abuse evaluation. Proof of attendance of said evaluation, must be submitted no later than April 26, 2022. If not received the board will review for further action and possible additional expulsion at the end of the six (6) month period. Documentation of participation and completion (if applicable) must be verified by information received by the Superintendent directly from the organization overseeing the Student's treatment. The Student and Parent agree that any recommendations regarding additional conditions for readmission that are made by the Student's therapist or program shall be binding and are incorporated herein by reference.

- That the Student must have no additional violations, arrests, or charges through the date of readmission.

- That written findings and conclusions consistent with the Board's deliberations will be prepared and the President is authorized and directed to execute the Findings of Fact and Conclusion.

The motion was seconded by Simmons. Roll call: Smith, Antonovich, Badgley, Simmons, Clark. Motion carried 5-0.

##### **V. Adjournment**

There was no further business to come before the Board for consideration at this time. Moved by Simmons, second by Badgley to adjourn the meeting. Roll call: Antonovich, Badgley, Simmons, Smith, Clark. Motion carried 5-0. President Clark adjourned the meeting at 6:57pm.
