Dave Johnson and Becky Roorda with the Friends of the Trail are in the process of creating an endowment to help maintain the Dalander Park prairie. This will help with ongoing maintenance costs.

Don Lincoln with the Madrid Area Chamber of Commerce provided an update. The Chamber's monthly meeting will be held Friday, November 12th and they are continuing to work on the website. The Christmas Extravaganza will be held December 4th and anyone interested in having a float can contact the Chamber.

Library Director Angie Strong provided the Council with the 2020-21 Annual Report. The library is still in search of a new library board member. The solar charger has not been received yet due to multiple shipping delays. The library has added a new database called A to Z World Travel that highlights popular travel destinations. Trick-or-Treat night was successful with over 300

Planning and Zoning Commission provided a recommendation for a zoning change request from R2 to C1 for empty lots located on N. Market Street. The majority of calls received for the properties are people interested in building a shop/warehouse. The owner thought he would have a better chance of selling the lots if they were zoned commercial.

Police Chief Tasler provided an update on the new police vehicle and his search for a part-time police officer.

Public Works Director Scott Church stated the water salesman is closed

for the year and the trailhead, softball/baseball field and Edgewood Park restrooms will be out of service on November 4th. Kybos will be available at Edgewood Park and the trailhead. Due to Alliant Energy removing poles and broken brackets from the derecho, there will be about 25 Christmas decorations that will be put up. Lane Shaver provided an update on his search for new Christmas decorations.

Marth Furness, Chairwoman for the Senior Activities Commission, stated the high school construction class is no longer an option to use to reconstruct the back steps of the SAM building and will have a construction company complete the work. Rentals for the building are increasing. The Board will be having a Black Friday Christmas decorating event on Friday, November 26th at 10:00 a.m. and volunteers are welcome to help. In an effort to add some new faces, the Board would like to have "Senior to Senior" advisory board members such as high school seniors or college level individuals. Advisory board members are allowed per the Ordinance and the process for appointment would remain the same

Councilperson Rigby stated the concrete path in Dalander Park is a great addition to the community.

City Administrator/Clerk Kristen Renslow stated the Iowa Legislature passed the redistricting maps on October 28th and the City Council will need begin the process of reviewing and submitting its precinct and ward boundaries to the Secretary of State

Mayor Brown stated the Anheuser-Busch building has been tuck-pointed on the front and work will begin in the back. He made a recommendation to City Council members to read 13 Ways to Kill Your Community by Doug Griffiths and it would be a good resource to help the Madrid community thrive.
