WHEREAS, due to the an-nouncement of the lowa Division of Labor, the Boone County Attorney has advised the Board of Supervisors that the penal provisions of the federal OSHA ETS would no longer apply to Boone County;

WHEREAS, it is now the express intent of the Board of Supervisors to rescind the previously approved "Boone County Mandatory Vaccina tion

WHEREAS, if it becomes evident that any further action is nec-essary due to either state or federal changes of policy or law, the Board of Supervisors will revisit the issue but will take further action by vote or subsequent resolution; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:
