NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MADRID, IOWA, 2018, BY REPEALING AND REPLACING TITLE VI, PHYSICAL ENVIRON- MENT, CHAPTER 16, FLOOD PLAIN MANAGEMENT

Notice Is Hereby Given: That at 6:00 o'clock p.m., at the City Hall Council Chambers, 304 S. Water Street, Madrid, Iowa, on September 7, 2021, the City Council of the City of Madrid, Iowa, will hold a public hearing on an ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Madrid, Iowa, 2018, by repealing and replacing Title VI, Physical Environment, Chapter 16, Flood Plain Management.

The proposed ordinance will reflect the new Boone County Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) that will become effective on October 21, 2021. The City of Madrid has participated in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) since 1976 and in order to remain in good standing with the program, the City is required to update its flood plain management ordinance to ensure it is fully compliant with NFIP regulations and to reference the new effective date of the maps. A copy of the proposed amended ordinance is on file for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk.

At said hearing any interested person may file written objections or comments and may be heard orally with respect to the subject matter of the hearing.
